### Job preparation assistance

In addition, Goodwill can help guide individuals to additional resources they may need.

### Job placement assistance

Disability Services staff continually develop relationships with employers in various industries. It is through these relationships that Goodwill staff members work with employers to carve new positions, become aware of current job openings and refer qualified individuals to an employer. We provide quality service to all of our customers.

### Ongoing support and follow-along services

Goodwill helps employees and employers establish good working relationships and identify strategies that will help employees become more successful in their jobs. Goodwill provides ongoing support on an individual basis. The intent of our follow-along service is to assist employees and employers by addressing any issues that may arise during employment. This may include teaching new skills or retraining when job functions change or a promotion is given.

- Show respect for others
- Seeking full- or part-time employment
- Have a medically documented disability
- Possess a state issued identification card and a Social Security Card
- Be alcohol and drug/substance free (illegal substances)
